Questions for Discussion *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. Why do we wear clothes?
2. What was the first “outfit” we read about in the Bible? (Go to Genesis 3 for help.)
3. Read Judges 6.34. What does it mean that Gideon was *clothed by the Spirit*?
4. Who is the Spirit?
5. How does the Holy Spirit clothe us?
6. How does being clothed by the Holy Spirit help us with our faith?

Questions for older children

1. How does the Holy Spirit help us understand and experience being clothed by Christ?
2. What is the difference between the ordinary power of the Holy Spirit and the special manifestations of the Holy Spirit’s power?
3. Why is being filled with the Holy Spirit a miracle?
