Questions for Discussion *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. How do we know there is only one God? (See Isaiah 45.5-6)
2. What does the word sovereign mean? (ask parents to help)
3. How does God reveal His sovereignty?
4. According to Isaiah 45.1-8, what all does God do?

Questions for older children

1. What is significant about Isaiah 45.7?
2. How does God use darkness to reveal His light?
3. How does God's sovereignty give us hope on our journey through dark times?
4. How does Jesus' own journey give us hope?

Scripture Memory for December: *(memorize these verses of Scripture this month)*

Isaiah 9.2, 6

The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone. ⁶For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
