#### **Questions for Discussion** *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

3. Why is it hard to be humble?
4. How can our relationship with Jesus create humility in our lives?
5. How should you pursue humility?

#### **Questions for older children**

1. Does the world value humility? Why or why not?
2. How does God respond to a lack of humility?
3. Why should humility be something every Christian longs for?
4. Where in your life do you need more humility?
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bring about change.

Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”
