2. What did they do?
3. What did Peter say had to be fulfilled?
4. How was the replacement for Judas determined?
5. What does this passage teach us about God leading His Church?

Questions for older children

1. What can we learn from the Apostles about how to wait on the Lord?
2. Why don’t we cast lots anymore?
3. Describe how you see the Lord fulfilling Scripture in this passage.
4. How do you see the Lord fulfilling Scripture today?
