### Hearing and Learning God's Word

#### **Scripture Reading:** Acts 2:5-13 *(one person read the Scripture aloud)*

#### **Questions for Discussion** *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several)*

1. Why did God send the Holy Spirit to the Church?
2. What does it mean to be a witness?
3. Why should we tell others about Jesus Christ?
4. What did the Jews celebrate during the feast of Pentecost? What does this have to do with our mission as Christ's Church?

#### **Questions for Older Children:**

1. What is the Great Commission? Who has God called to fulfill the Great Commission?
2. What miracle happened at Pentecost? What does this miracle teach us about world missions?
3. What is reconciliation? How has God reconciled us to Himself?
4. What role does the Holy Spirit play in evangelism?

#### **Scripture Memory for October:** *(memorize this passage of Scripture this month)*

Acts 2:42-43

And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.
