Questions for Discussion *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. To what group of people is Peter preaching?
2. What is Peter learning for himself as he sees the power of God at work on this new frontier?
3. What is the gospel according to Peter’s sermon?
4. Why do you think the Gospel is such a powerful message?
5. The Holy Spirit is joining the Gentiles into the Holy Spirit’s work at Pentecost *(from Acts 2)*. Now they are all together in one body, with one Spirit. How does this prove Peter’s point in verse 34?
6. What are some places where you want to see God work? How can you pray for those people and places? Where is God sending you to share the gospel with others?

Scripture Memory for February: *(memorize this passage of Scripture this month)*

Acts 16.30-31.

Then he brought them out and said, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?”

³¹ And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.”
