4. Why do you think God used Ananias to minister to Saul?
5. Why does God use us??

Questions for older children

1. If you could have asked Ananias anything after he met with Saul, what would you have asked him?
2. What can we learn about God’s desire to use us in extending His Kingdom from this story?
