Questions for Discussion: *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. Who is the Holy Spirit?
2. How do we see the Holy Spirit at work in this passage?
3. When they follow the Spirit, what do they do with the gospel?
4. What does the Holy Spirit tell them to do and not do?
5. What happens to Lydia and how was the Holy Spirit at work?

Questions for older children

1. How can we discern the call of the Holy Spirit?
2. What lessons are here for us about the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives?
3. When have you experienced the “red light green light” work of the Spirit with the gospel?

Scripture Memory for April *(memorize this passage of Scripture this month)*

Acts 14.21-22

When they had preached the gospel to that city and had made many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch, strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith, and saying that through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God.
