Questions for Discussion: (*may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times*)

1. What is the Great Commission? What does it mean to make disciples?
2. What are the essential elements of the Gospel message?
3. Is there anyone in your life that needs to hear the good news of Jesus Christ?
4. What is your story of rescue? How would you share that story with others?
5. How does God use suffering for our good and the good of others?
6. According to 1 Corinthians, what is evangelism without love?
7. What does the Cross teach us about the cost of making disciples?

Scripture Memory for May (*memorize this passage of Scripture this month*)

Psalm 52.8-9 (NLT)

But I am like an olive tree, thriving in the house of God. I will always trust in God’s unfailing love. ⁹ I will praise You forever, O God, for what You have done. I will trust in Your good name in the presence of Your faithful people.
