Scripture Reading: Acts 5.1-11; Matthew 13.44 *(one person read the Scripture aloud)*

Questions for Discussion: *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. What is a parable?
2. What is the lesson from the parable of the hidden treasure?
3. Is the story of Ananias and Sapphira a parable?
4. What are some of the lessons from this story?

Questions for older children

1. Why is the story of Ananias and Sapphira important for the Church?
2. What does this story and the parable teach us about treasures?
3. What does it mean to fear God?
4. How do these passages lead you to think about treasures in your own life?

Scripture Memory for June *(memorize this passage of Scripture this month)*

Matthew 13.44-46

The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up. Then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. ⁴⁵ Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls, ⁴⁶ who, on finding one pearl of great value, went and sold all that he had and bought it.
