Hearing and Learning God’s Word

Questions for Discussion: *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. What does it mean to be made in the image of God? What does it mean to be a priest? How are we called to be God’s representatives?
2. What made the sin of Eli’s sons so heinous?
3. What is blasphemy? How do we take the Lord’s name in vain in other ways besides swearing?
4. What was God’s judgment against Eli and his sons? What does this judgment tell us about the character of God?
5. What was God’s promise in verse 35? What does this promise tell us about the character of God?
6. Who is the ultimate “faithful priest”? What has this “faithful priest” done for us?
