Hearing and Learning God’s Word

Scripture Reading: 1 Samuel 9.1-6, 14-16, 10.1-13 *(one person read the Scripture aloud)*

Questions for Discussion: *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. What does it mean to be ruled by God?
2. What is the providence of God? Where do we see God’s providence in the story of Saul?
3. Does God’s providence make Him more or less relational with us? Why?
4. What does the Holy Spirit have to do with the Kingdom of God? How does the Holy Spirit rule us today?
5. How did God restrain the people of Israel through the kingship of Saul? What did He restrain them from?
6. How was Saul the king that the people wanted? Why is Jesus the King that we really need?
