Questions for Discussion: *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. What does the word “worship” mean? When do we worship? Other than music, what are some ways that we worship God?
2. When was the last time you experienced awe? What was it that filled you with awe? Describe how you felt.
3. What does reverence have to do with the holiness of God?
4. What is joy? How is joy different than happiness?
5. Why did the ark’s arrival in Jerusalem fill David with so much joy? What did David’s joy look like?
6. Why was David wearing a linen ephod instead of his kingly robes? What does this tell us about David’s posture before the Lord?
