(one person read the Scripture aloud)

Questions for Discussion: *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. What is temptation?
2. Who tempts us?
3. How does Peter describe Satan in 1 Peter 5.8? Why do you think he describes him this way?
4. How can we resist Satan?
5. How should David have resisted Satan?
6. How did Christ teach us to resist Satan?
7. Who can you talk to about your temptations?

Scripture Memory for April: *(memorize this passage of Scripture this month)*

If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.
