### Hearing and Learning God’s Word

**Scripture Reading:** 2 Samuel 12.1-14 *(one person read the Scripture aloud)*

**Questions for Discussion:** *(may be answered in one worship time or spread over several times)*

1. In 2 Samuel 12.9, what does Nathan emphasize as David’s sin?
2. What does despise mean? How did David despise the word of the Lord?
3. How do people despise the word of the Lord?
4. How is despising the word of the Lord evil?
5. How might we despise the word of the Lord, but not think it is that evil?
6. Why is it important to see our sin from God’s view?
7. For those who trust in Jesus Christ for their salvation, how do they look in God’s sight?

**Scripture Memory for May:** *(memorize this passage of Scripture this month)*

2 Samuel 22.31-32

This God—His way is perfect; the word of the LORD proves true; He is a shield for all those who take refuge in Him. For who is God, but the LORD? And who is a rock, except our God?
